## Official Information Act Request

The Ministry of Health transferred your Official Information Act request regarding facilities using fossil fuels to district health boards on 2 September 2021.

- A list of all hospital, mental health wards, psychiatric care facilities, rest homes & healthcare facilities as well as administrative & miscellaneous buildings the Ministry of Health knows are using fossil fuels, with a breakdown of fossil fuel type, and region.
- 2. An outline of any plans that the Ministry of Health or Energy Efficiency Conservation Authority have to transition these institutions off fossil fuels, and the names of these institutions and the transition plan.

Northland DHB has already phased out all the diesel boilers at our three rural hospitals (Dargaville, Bay of Islands and Kaitaia hospitals) so they are fully electric now. In 2020 Northland DHB in collaboration with EECA was the first DHB to join and execute the Energy Transition Acceleration Programme of EECA for the Whangarei Hospital site which consumes natural gas. The insights are now used together with a decarbonisation budget under the capital works programme to transition away from natural gas consumption over the next 5-10 years pending capital expenditure allowance for future financial years.

Northland DHB supports the open disclosure of information to assist public understanding of how we deliver our services. This includes proactive publication of anonymised Official Information Act responses on our website from 10 working days after they have been provided to you. Personal or identifying information will be redacted from any response published online. If you consider there are good reasons why this response should not be publicly available we will consider your views.
