

## Official Information Act Request

You have asked for information services provided to people who stutter.

Would you please advise: whether you do provide services for people who stutter?

Northland DHB provides a service for adult patients. Our Paediatric Speech Language Therapy Service provides communication intervention for children with disabilities under the age of three years. It does not provide a service for children who stutter.

If you do provide services for people who stutter, would you please advise:

 how many people who stutter that you have worked with in the last year including a breakdown of their ages and ethnicities

One patient was referred and seen in the past year; 75 year old, NZ European.

 the type of services that you provided, e.g. individual speech therapy, group programmes

the number of sessions of individual speech therapy you provided in the last year

 the number of any other programmes etc that you offered and the number of participants in these programmes.
